A hygienist has been specially trained to carry out scaling and polishing and can spend longer with you. They are also expert at teaching you how to look after your teeth and gums. Often the hygienist will spend a number of appointments with a patient getting the gums healthy which will provide strong foundations should any restorative work need to be carried out by the Dentist.

Angela will be working with us every Wednesday from the start of the year.

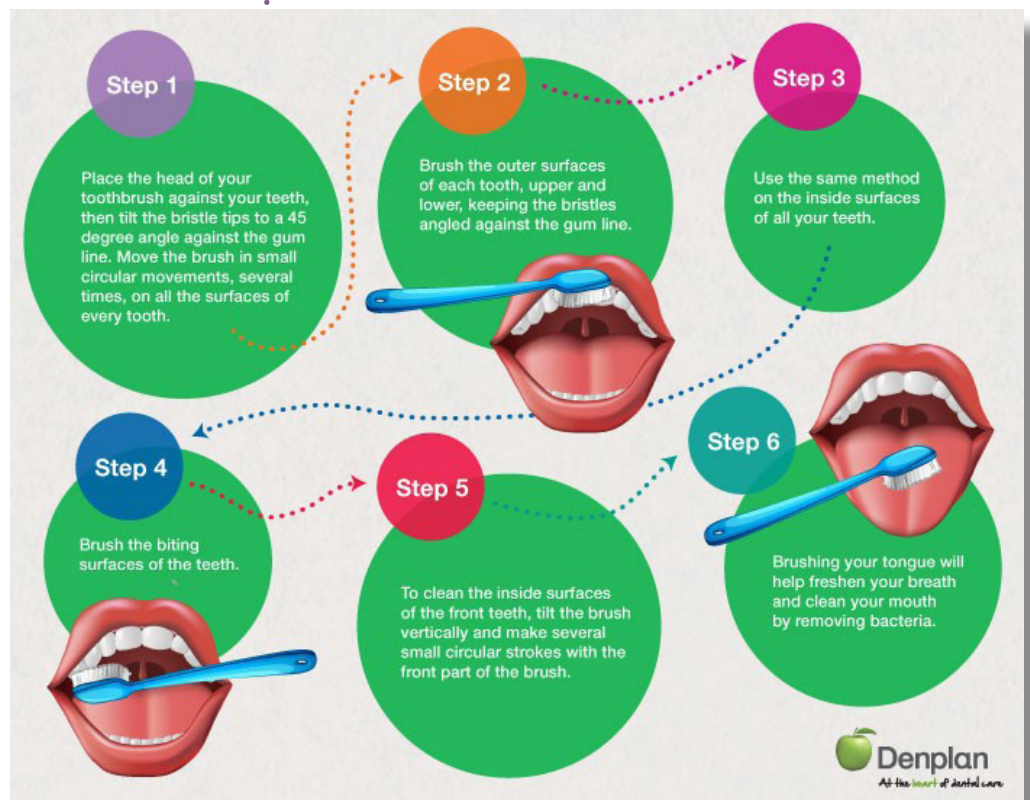
